Garsington Opera is looking to appoint a pool of Stage Technicians for our upcoming 2026 season.

Main Responsibilities

To assist the Head of Stage and Stage Management in the running of the stage during technical rehearsals, daytime changeovers and show running.

Key Task Areas

- Taking on show cues during performances and general duties required for the running of performances and on-stage rehearsals
- Ensure all staging requirements of the productions are prepared to an excellent standard and are ready and functioning for rehearsals and performances
- Maintain a good practice of health and safety in all areas and report any problems to the Senior Stage Technician
- Assist, when required, in ensuring all under-stage and orchestra areas are set for the performance
- To construct minor scenic elements relevant to skill level and to undertake minor technical alterations to scenery
- To help maintain scenery and props to the highest standard possible
- Maintain a tidy and clean working environment in all backstage areas in general and as requested by the Senior Stage Technician
- To carry out any other task that will, from time to time be allocated by the Senior Stage Technician, Technical Director or Head of Stage on an ad hoc or continuing basis, relevant with the general level of responsibility of the post

Personal Specification

Essential

- Flexibility, stamina and ability to multi-task and a reliable time-keeper
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong foundation skills in stage craft
- Basic knowledge of current Health & Safety working practices
- Ability to demonstrate a calm approach when working closely with other technical staff and performers in pressured situations
- Attention to detail
- Fully conversant in stage terminology
- Ability to work as part of a close-knit team in an enclosed environment, working towards a deadline

Desirable

- To hold or be willing to undertake training for: IPAF, First Aid, Tallescope, rigging and working at height
- Knowledge and experience of basic power tool operation and carpentry skills
- Full Driving licence and own car
